



SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

ST PAULS COLLEGE is dedicated to getting the best students into higher education and helping them succeed. Scholarships are provided by the university, government and non-government entities, and benefactors to ensure that no student is denied the chance due to financial inadequacy. Scholarships are awarded to students who demonstrate both financial need and academic excellence. In the institution's scholarship policy, the management's approach to awarding scholarships is outlined in detail. If scholarships are provided by the university and government, the granting authority directly deposits the scholarship into the student's bank account.

Management Scholarship

ST PAULS COLLEGE is dedicated to empowering students by extending the right to education to higher education. As part of its institutional social duty, the college's administration provides scholarships to help deserving students complete their higher education. According to the conditions outlined in this document, these scholarships may pay tuition and other relevant expenditures, as applicable.

Coverage

The candidates are eligible to avail themselves of the following concessions:

- A concession in tuition fees
- Boarding and lodging expenses
- Lunch is provided for free.
- Funding of a field trip or any similar excursion made in fulfilment of coursework requirements

Eligibility

- The candidate must be an Indian citizen.
- Have met the minimum attendance requirements stipulated by college regulations.
- Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of one or more of the following criteria:
 - a. Marks scored on PUC/12th std. examinations for the financially meritorious
 - b. Academic performance from the previous year (for the second and third years)
 - c. Academic differentiation for students with differing abilities
 - d. Excellence in social work or community service and in sports

Application Process

Candidates must fill out the application form available at the college office and submit it with self-attested copies of the requisite documents, as specified in the annual circular, within the allotted time frame. When requested, candidates must present these documents in their original form for verification by the office. Incomplete or inaccurate applications will not be accepted.

Selection

The administration shall establish a selection committee consisting of the principal, vice principal, and administrator as ex-officio members. The committee will define and review annually the objective criteria that will be used to evaluate the applications. Such criteria would be communicated to the students via a circular. The selection committee will be in charge of developing criteria, evaluating applications, and awarding scholarships. The committee's decision will be final and binding.

Conditions for Termination of Scholarship Award

The award may be terminated at any given point in time if it is found that the candidate has furnished incorrect details or particulars in their application or is found guilty of malpractice, misconduct, and violation of college policies, rules, and regulations.
